

Virtual Programs Scholarship (VPS) Entry Form

EdOdyssey virtual scholarships are merit-based scholarships for <u>only</u> students studying any Virtual Study Abroad course, including "The Latinx Patient: Spanish and Culture for Healthcare". VPS applications get reviewed and awarded on a rolling, "first come, first serve" basis. In order to apply you must be registered for an EdOdyssey program. VPS applications are accepted within thirty (30) days after their program registration deadline.

Enrolled participants are eligible for VSA scholarships. Scholarship recipients who show passion and enthusiasm, and best connect with our prompt(s), will be eligible to receive between \$50-\$200 dollars for approved scholarships toward an EdOdyssey virtual course. Please review this form in its entirety before starting your entry.

Note: Some programs may not be eligible for scholarships depending on the agreement with the school/university. If you're not sure, please just contact us and we will be happy to help.

Prompt 1: Young Global Citizens

We live in a globalized world, and being a global citizen makes a huge difference! Global citizens are always looking to expand their knowledge of their world, and in their mission to learn from an international scope, develop crucial communication and cultural competency skills to understand people from different backgrounds.

- Why do you feel it is important to engage in meaningful dialogue or experiences with people of different identities or backgrounds from yours?

Our scholarship committee encourages participants to critically reflect on this interaction or experience and how it has influenced their goals, interests, and perspectives. We also encourage students to use their talents and submit the application material that they believe best represents them as a person and learner, and that demonstrates their strengths and passions.

Your scholarship entry will be judged based on how well it reflects our company values -Authenticity, Positivity, Harmony, Passion, Professionalism, and Adaptability - and our motto "Travel Changes People, People Change the World". Our scholarship committee looks for insightful responses from enthusiastic students who are excited to open themselves to new experiences from different cultures. We will be receiving applications either as written responses or creative expressions through photographs or videos.
