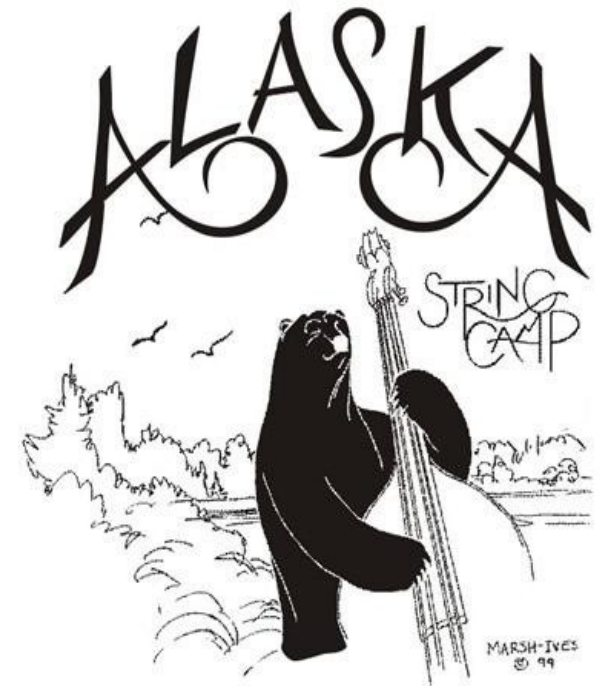

# Alaska String Camps

Alaska String Camps offers three different orchestra camps for students playing violin, viola, cello, and double bass. Each camp is tailored to a different age group to ensure a blend of fun and learning. Aside from playing in the orchestra, campers also get the opportunity to play in small ensembles, get small-group instruction on their instrument, theory activities, and plenty of time to run around outside and enjoy nature.

Instructors include state and national clinicians, school district and private music teachers, as well as musicians from the Anchorage Symphony Orchestra and Anchorage Opera.

Our recreation directors oversee group fun including swimming, hiking, boating, volleyball, soccer and campfires on the shore of picturesque Psalm Lake. Snacks, social time, and staff concerts round out our days.

A music educator for 40 years, this year's conductor Lynne Tobin teaches general music and strings at the Pathfinder School, plays cello with the Traverse Symphony and conducts the unique multi-generational Civic String Ensembles for the TSO. A graduate of Interlochen Arts Academy, Lynne holds music degrees from the University of Michigan and Northern Illinois University. Prior to moving to MI, Lynne taught in Georgia for many years. The Mayor of Savannah declared April 18, 1994 "Lynne Tobin Day" to thank her for her musical work with children in the community.

## **ELEMENTARY: GRADES 4-6      \$390**

Designed with the younger camper in mind, this camp is open to those students with at least one school year of playing experience and who will have completed grade four, five, or six. For three days and two nights students will enjoy orchestra rehearsals, fiddling, music theory, and outdoor recreation. The experience culminates in a family concert on the final day of camp.

## **INTERMEDIATE: GRADES 7-8      \$500**

Intermediate Camp is open to young string players who have played for at least one school year and have completed seventh or eighth grade. Students enjoy four days and three nights of orchestra rehearsals, technique, music theory, improvisation, and many recreational activities. A family concert is held on the final evening of camp to demonstrate the campers' accomplishments.

## **HIGH SCHOOL: GRADES 9-12      \$550**

High School Camp is open to those students who have played for at least two years and have completed the ninth grade. It combines the traditional string camp orchestra rehearsals with a relaxed atmosphere and a variety of elective courses. Electives offered in the past have included fiddling, composition, ballroom dancing, music of different cultures, electronics in music, small ensembles, and technique. The camp has been extended to five days and four nights and ends with a family concert.
