## RULES OF CHALLENGE FOR SINGLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT

Coach,

All teams need to complete the *AYBT ROSTER/PERMISSION TO TREAT*. When you sign in your team on Saturday, you will need to submit this form (with full roster and parent signatures) to one of the tournament directors.

The roster/permission to treat will be your playing roster for the single elimination tournament on Sunday.

\*If a player is to participate in the single elimination tournament he/she must have played in at least one (1) of the games in the Saturday pool play.

## **RULES OF CHALLENGE FOR SINGLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT**

- 1. Only the head coach (or coach in charge) of the team can challenge a player of another team. The challenge must be a "legitimate challenge in the interest of fair play."
- 2. There will be no challenges in the Saturday round robin play.
- 3. **There is a challenge deposit of \$50.** If the challenge is upheld, the \$50 will be returned. If the challenge is not upheld, the \$50 will not be returned.
- 4. The player being challenged must be on the team roster (permission to treat form) prior to Sunday tournament play and had played in at least one (1) of the games in round robin play. The tournament directors will collect the roster/permission to treat forms on Saturday.
- 5. Challenge must occur prior to the tip off of the game in question. Challenge will be *reported to the officials by the coach.* One of the officials will then report it to the tournament directors.
- **6.** The player must have age/grade verification (copy of birth certificate, driver's license, student ID, report card, yearbook, etc). **The decision of the tournament directors is final.**
