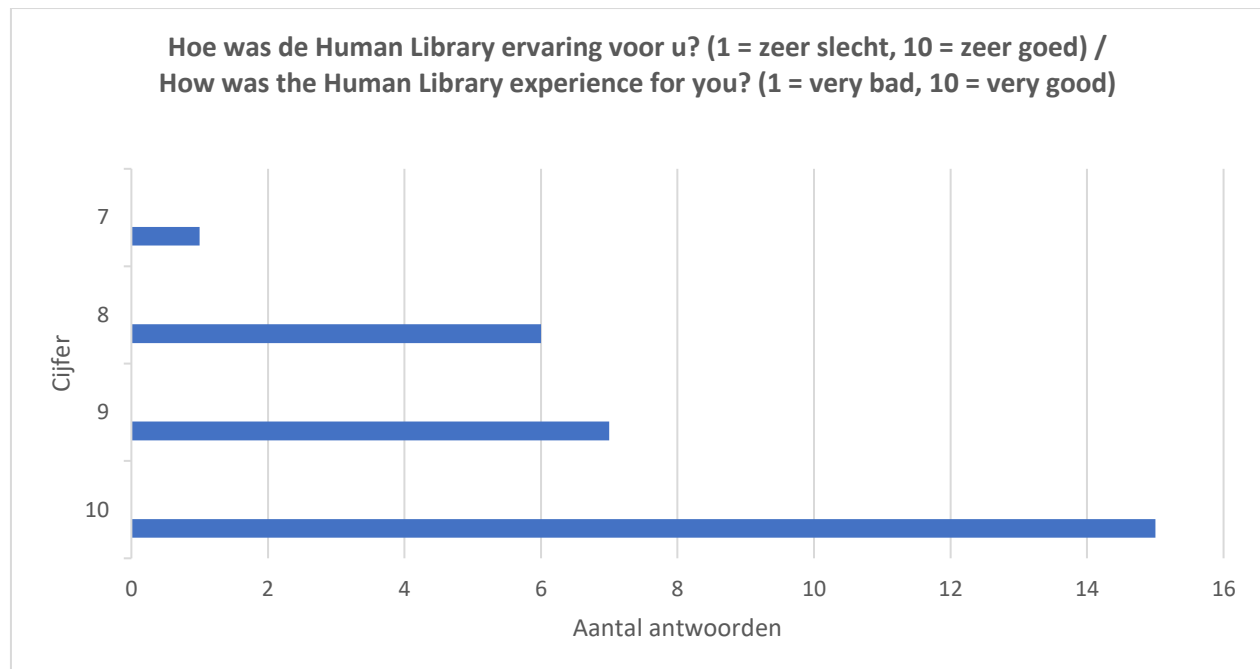


Evaluatieverslag Human Library Groningen, 15-10-2017

Op 15 oktober 2017 vond de vijfde editie van de Human Library in Groningen plaats, van 13:00 tot 17:00 uur. Er vonden 37 gesprekken plaats en er waren 9 boeken te leen: Angststoornis, BDSM, Kanker, HIV (man), HIV (vrouw), Iraanse vrouw, Helderziend, Syrische vluchteling en Transgender. De dag werd begeleid door 7 vrijwilligers.
