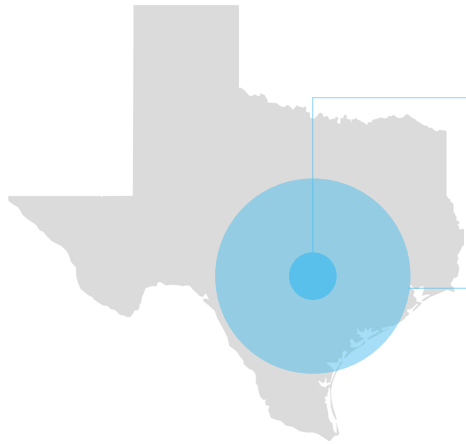

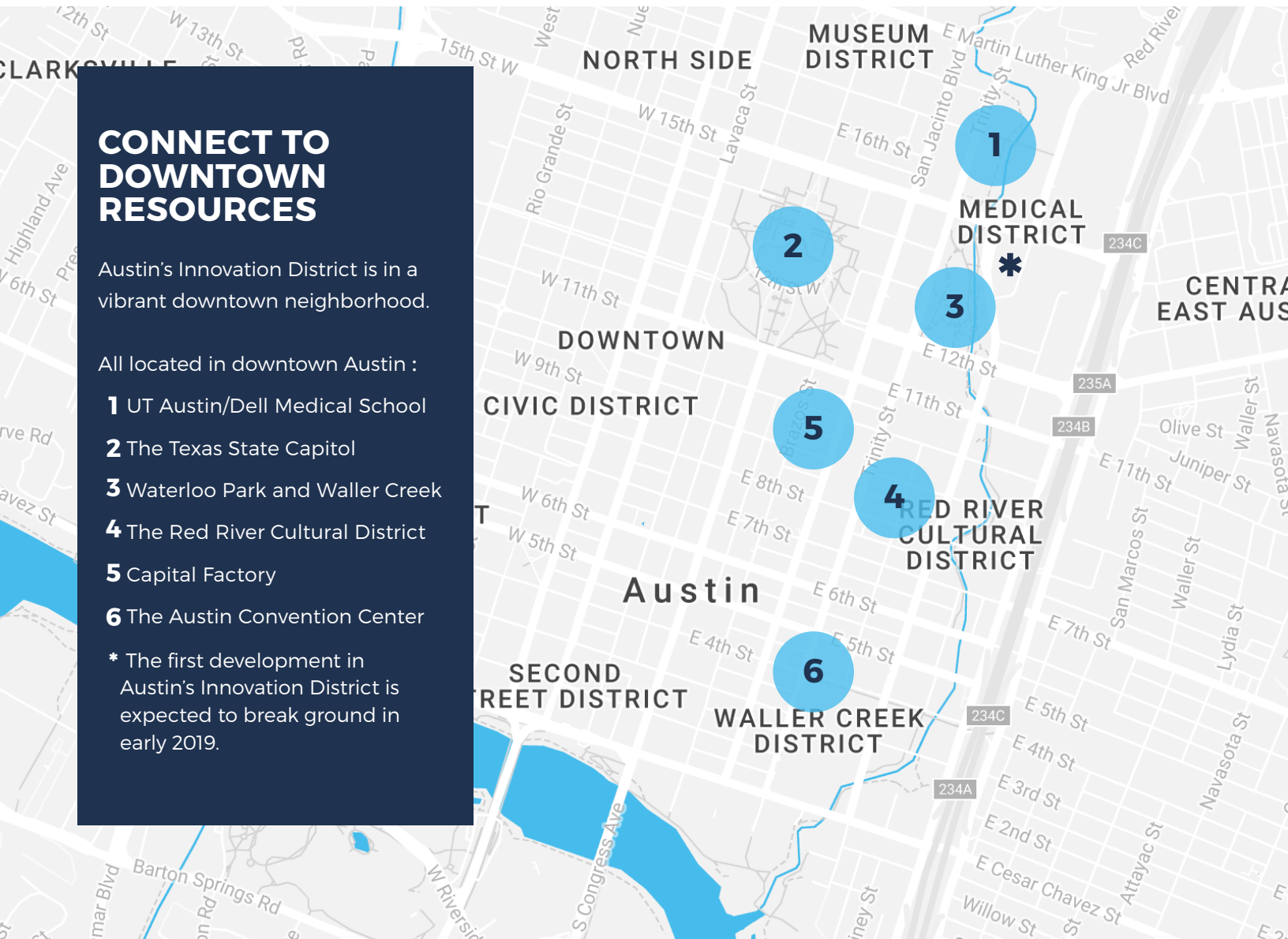
CONNECT TO DOWNTOWN RESOURCES

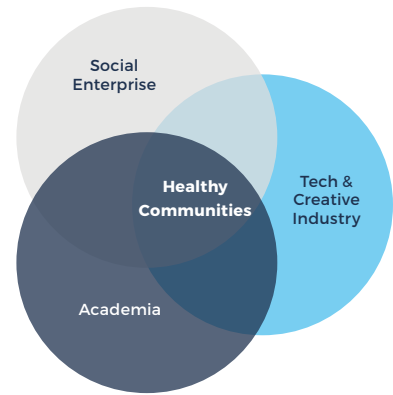
