Educational Outcomes Awards

I am delighted to announce that our excellent outcomes have been recognised by SSAT (The Schools, Students and Teachers Network) in this year's Educational Outcomes Awards. CGA is among the highest performing secondary schools in the country, based on 2023 performance data and information from Ofsted. CGA was recognised in two categories, receiving awards for being in the top 20% of schools nationally for student progress and in the top 10% of non-selective schools for student attainment in the 2023 end of KS4 exams. For us to be recognised with an Educational Outcomes Award is a significant achievement and a testament to the work of the whole school community, including parents.
