

2021 was certainly the most incredible year of ministry New Covenant Missions has experienced since our founding in 2001. Thanks to your partnership our work continued to expand and is now active among 252 unreached people groups across 25 African Nations. Our teams were able to share the Gospel with 252,773 people, most of whom had never had an opportunity to hear it before. Even more exciting than that, 30,275 of those people decided to follow Jesus— an astounding 65.8% increase over the prior year! This resulted in 1,841 new churches planted in 2021. This is over 1,000 more churches than we have ever planted in a 12-month period. In addition to these wonderful statistics, our teams trained 1,840 leaders in church planting among the unreached. I personally was blessed to witness the fruit of these leadership trainings with the launch of our new work among the unengaged Bainouk people of The Gambia.

In early Fall of 2021 one of our partners asked me if we could reach the Bainouk of The Gambia. I had never heard of them but after doing research I was confident we could try. I felt it might be a “Macedonian Call” or I guess really a “Bainoukian Call”(Acts 16:9). Within just one month we already had a team prepared to go and live among the Bainouks to present the love of Jesus. I knew I had to go and see for myself how this came together so fast.

Our National Coordinator, Modou, had found a man of peace in a Bainouk village and it just so happened that he was one of the only known Evangelical Christians among the people group. His village was 400 years old and while the Bainouks were originally very tied to their traditional beliefs, all but Chief Bakary and his family had become Muslim. Bakary learned about Jesus from his brother that had moved to the city and this Chief was holding fast to his faith in Christ.

Bakary had been praying for someone to come and help him bring the light to his village. He was only able to remain Chief because of his bloodline and the people were getting impatient with his choice to not follow them in their Islamic faith. Additionally, the very little community development in the area came by way of a Sheik in the Middle East so Bakary himself was starting to feel defeated. As we sat and shared our vision, Bakary’s eyes lit up with hope. By the end of our conversation, he was ready to just start giving land for churches to be planted. We had to counsel him that we should be wise as the serpent and gentle as the dove as we begin this work. As we drove away, I was completely stunned how God had heard Bakary’s plea for help, put the Bainouk of The Gambia on a Finishing the Task unengaged unreached people list so that 10,000 miles away



our partner would see it and inquire with us, and then gave our teams the path to find Bakary amid 31,000 Bainouks living in the riverside forests of The Gambia.

I trust you will be encouraged by the many amazing testimonies featured in this report of 2021. We truly could not have done the work without your prayers and financial support. 2022 is off to an incredible start as we launch work among nine new unengaged unreached people groups, witness the churches we planted in 2021 already begin to multiply, impact unreached communities with dozens of community projects such as fresh water, health clinics, large scale medical missions, and various economic relief projects. God is guiding us on the path to see a body of believers in every community across Africa!

Azebu People- Shortly after launching our project to reach the Azebu of Ethiopia during the 3rd quarter of 2020, a terrible civil war broke out. Thankfully the team was still able to work through the 1st quarter of 2021 and 547 people heard the Gospel with 17 Azebu deciding to follow Jesus in that time. Unfortunately, in the 2nd quarter of 2021 the civil war moved right into the Azebu area of the Tigray region and we lost all contact with the team of two CP's, Ayalew (wife and 2 children) & Gebrehiwot (single). Electricity has been cut, all businesses shut down, there has been no water and no food for the most part. Truthfully, we were worried that they would be dead.

Thankfully, on February 6th a friend of our CP's named Gidey was able to get out of the region to the neighboring Amhara state and make a phone call to our Regional Director to let us know that Ayalew & Gebrehiwot are alive. Unfortunately they are all experiencing terrible suffering. Praise God, we have found a way to get some resources to them to help them through this challenging season. Additionally, we are seeing the situation of the war slowly changing for the good and we are praying confidently for an end to this terrible situation in Northern Ethiopia. We have tried to move the church planter team out of the Tigray region, but unfortunately at this time that will cause either imprisonment or even possibly death.





Instead, she loved going to church because she knew that one day she was going to get her healing and be completely delivered from the evil powers that were afflicting her for many years. Sister Hawa had been oppressed since her childhood and had always told her parents that she prefers the church to the mosque but her parents would beat her and keep her in the house for days without anything to eat. “Even though we are restricted in many ways, the working power of God cannot be denied. Apart from the way some pay keen attention to the Word of God during our outreaches, many sneak to receive prayers at night. Most of them, women, use the opportunity to share their fears with us. They are afraid of rejection, divorce, persecution and banishment which are commonly used against serious offenders in the land. But I believe with the counsel they are receiving from the Word of God, many will have the courage to make the most important life decision soon. We have heard of healings, restorations and breakthrough. Yet, there are very heavy restrictions as we are not allowed to freely pay visits to some areas.”



“We have been doing an underground work in *-undisclosed location-* since we were heavily resisted by the Muslim community. Some people have seen the light and want to follow Christ, but the leaders are not allowing them to. But now, since we had a medical outreach, where we gave out free medications and prayed for some, we are able to have better movement around the people. Only God can speak to their hearts, because, they are not an easy to reach people group. During the program seven people came at night to give their lives to Christ. After the program, on Sunday morning a sister came to join us of her own accord. This is the beginning of many testimonies!”

“We went on a medical outreach to our new field . Many of them came to receive free medication at camp and we used the opportunity to preach the Gospel.

One of them was the first lady we spoke with the very first time we entered *-undisclosed location-* . To my amazement, she has been waiting for this for a long time. She gave her life to Christ, requested a Bible and submitted herself for prayers without fear. This lady is a teacher in a private school, is a single mother and I saw in her as a tool in the hand of God. This can only be God. This is the same town we were not allowed to enter some time back, but with prayers and strategy, God is beginning to give us favor in the land. Amen.”



“There are many reasons we will not give up preaching the Gospel. One reason is because some of the people who opposed us in the beginning are starting to know the truth and we have many secret disciples. On Sunday the 21st of November 2021 we met a young man. He was one of the difficult ones who used to mock the new believers for joining the church. But this time he asked us to pray with him and we then also shared the Gospel and he surrendered his life to Jesus Christ.”

During the outreach a 19 year old Jula Muslim girl name Yakubu Mariyam gave her life to Jesus. It was her first time going to church since she was born. This church is officially pastored by pastor Peter Biye Sibiti NCM NC of Ghana with 15 new believers. They are now worshipping in the porch of a house while praying for God's provision to have a church building in the community. Glory be to God for the great work that has been done by the VOC and the NCM team.



“We presented the Jesus film in Yipaala. Yipaala has a population of about 2000 and is dominated with idol worshipers, a few Muslims and 1 percent Christianity. We went to the chief's place to seek permission, but unfortunately we could not meet the chief. Thankfully, his linguist gave us permission to show the Jesus film close to their central mosques. They received us well and the Muslims who went for their evening prayers stopped by to watch the film to the end. It is our prayer that the Holy Spirit draws them to Jesus.” **NCM CP Samson**



Mr Kwame Jowatey from Abasumah village shared that his father was an idol worshiper and through the father all the children were initiated into idol worship. His father had been ill for more than a year and they could find no solution to his problem. Kwame invited us to prayer for his father, but his father told us that he did not need our prayers. 


THE TESTIMONY OF THE FIRST KNOWN UBI BELIEVER

"Mupapa is a vast village in Tamboland with 550 people villagers. The gospel was presented to 38 people, 30 people gave their lives to Jesus Christ. We have just started outreaches in this village and it was such a joy to see some villagers receiving the gospel though others resisted us. The 30 new believers were added to the discipleship group in Kantembe village which is gradually growing." **NCM CP Joel**



"I am Charles Bowa aged 28. I live in Kantembe village of Tamboland. One day I insulted the church planter who was sharing the Word of God in our village. My life was that of drinking alcohol. One day I saw that the group of Christians were receiving second hand clothes. The planter saw me and I was afraid that he would chase me away but he called me to also come and receive some clothes. Rev Bowa did it with so much joy and this amazed me because it wasn't long ago that I had insulted him! When he said God doesn't choose whom to love, these words touched my heart because I didn't deserve this kind of love. So I sobbed and thought to myself, if this is the kind of God these people are following I want to do the same. The Rev saw me and came to pray for me and led me to the Lord. I am now following the same Jesus I insulted because of the love I experienced that day."

COMMUNITY PROJECTS



TANZANIA ORPHANAGE PROJECT

FIRST AND SECOND QUARTER

The Good Shepherd's House is taking care of 10 children; 6 Girls and 4 Boys from 3-17 years old. Youngsters at the Good Shepherd's House are nurtured to grow well spiritually (through Bible studies, worship & prayer programs), academically (schools, receiving school supplies, etc.), and physically (healthier through food, and sports). We are currently continuing with the construction work of the Good Shepherd's House at Ngyeku village in Arumeru, district of Arusha; This house shall be able to accommodate a total of ten children and staff; by God's grace 10 youngsters shall be developed into being self-sustained with good health, education, and useful life skills that will also be inspired to help others. We have seen transformation in the lives of the children in areas of our reach. It brings joy when we see children grow spiritually by becoming part of the church family. They are also learning to be part of a community, growing in the knowledge of God's Word and in faith.

For this project to effectively serve children, we need 3 staff members to be serving in this house. The average monthly budget for this project is \$1,600 USD which started in 2018 and has been seeking support to make it more effective so as to impact lives of children in Tanzania. If you would like to support these young people you can pray or/and give towards their food, school fees & supplies, medical needs, construction of the House on our website.



THE BUILDING OF THE ORPHANAGE IN TANZANIA



Up to the end of the year 2021, thirty two needy children have been reached and their lives touched by the Love of God as they got the opportunity to fellowship, involve in Bible Studies, receive food and school supplies to start their new academic year in 2022. We praise and thank God for the ongoing support through NCM to assist these needy children in Tanzania. ‘Bwana asifiwe’ (Praise the Lord).



“For thirteen years, the initiative to build the Good Shepherd’s House continued, and the house has been under construction for such a long time due to the shortage of funding, with slow donations. Prayers while continuing to trust God has been the key to move forward.

In 2008, God so divinely connected Michael with Erik, who became friends to date. These two brothers and now co-workers have been continuously praying for each other and for the mission work. It was just wonderful on how finally NCM has been used by God to be His instrument for the financial support to not only help furnish the Good Shepherd’s House in Tanzania, but also to support this work in a regular basis. We are thankful to God because of all donors who so generously supported the ongoing mission work in Africa and Tanzania in particular. It has been possible because you stand with us!

It brings us joy to see children who had no clothes, to get at-least one more cloth, or one more pair of shoes as he/she had none. We live in an area where many children are suffering in many ways. We are happy to see the children smile, knowing that they will get at-least two meals a day while at first he/she was having only one little meal or just a porridge for a whole day. We see God meeting the needs of those who are suffering, and touching them by His unlimited love. Let us continue to be His instrument as He keeps doing this good work among us.”



Giving of Clothes, Shoes, and Food to children of the Good Shepherd’s House!

Although our primary focus is on the children of the Good Shepherd's House, we do our best to be of help to more children because of the great need in the community. We have found that there are still families that have only one meal per day. We have therefore decided to use weekends to share food with needy children living on the streets to show them the love of God. We hope that improved lives of children will bring up a better next generation that knows the Lord due to the shared truth of the Gospel, and access to good education. Participation of children in the ongoing Bible fellowships has shown us what the future looks like as God is at work to prepare more laborers for His Service. Praise GOD!

PROGRESS OF WORK AT THE GOOD SHEPHERD'S HOUSE




We praise God for the construction work done at the Good Shepherd's House in the year 2021, that included the completed work regarding: 1. Plumbing, 2. Aluminum windows, 3. Wall fence, 4. Putting up the Gypsum board on the ceiling of the house, 5. Installing tiles on the floor, 6. Ordering beds for the house.

Government Officers from the Social Welfare Department visited the Good Shepherd's House for inspection. They advised that the wall fence should be completed in the remaining half side for the security of the children. Though it was not within our recent building plans, we found it good to do it to continue and to be accepted by the Government as it meets all requirements. For the next phase we will be working on the water systems (i.e. drilling water holes for the Project), for domestic use as well as farming.

We look forward to starting the year 2022 with the effective use of the house. We are thankful to God that this construction work, that took 13 years, has finally come to its end. We praise God for His faithfulness and for leading people to give so as to support this work.

We have 3 workers who have been actively involved with the childrens program. Doors are open for more volunteers to join effort. Reaching out and be of support by touching lives of up to 32 children in our reach, even by sharing food with others in the streets is of encouragement. HEALTH CENTERS

FIRST AND SECOND QUARTER

► CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

This new medical center is the first and only of its kind for the 3,200 Benkonjo people of Central African Republic. It will be staffed by a trained nurse and stocked with the medical supplies needed to prevent death from treatable diseases such as malaria, typhoid fever, dysentery, and more.



► DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO



Our new Ndunga Health Center in Democratic Republic of Congo has 10 rooms with the objective of doing surgery, having pregnant women deliver, and treatment of various illnesses such as malaria, typhoid, and dysentery.

► GARRE OF ETHIOPIA

New Covenant Missions Ethiopia Provides Fresh Water for the Garre!

This is one of the ponds where the Garre people fetch drinking water for their daily consumption. In the Dawa zone there is no river or spring but only ponds that are being filled during rainy season. We met several women who were fetching water from this pond coming from far distance riding donkeys. A woman was explaining how they suffer as a result of a lack of pure water. She said “God brought you here to support us”. The community leaders and water committee were present as well. We later visited the same place to discuss all details and selected the site where to implement the water tanks for our clean water project!

Garre as a people group are forgotten by everyone. They say the government of Ethiopia doesn't consider them as Ethiopians, they don't have enough resources apart from their cattle and have no peace and no water. They are not only grateful for NCM's water project, but thanked God.

► BOM KRIM OF SIERRA LEONE

“The condition of the people of Sampoo was very bad. The entire community was using the bushes and the creek for their toilet which was causing contamination in their drinking water. As a result of their situation, many of them got sick and died especially the elderly and children. The chief said since the establishment of Sampoo, no one has ever built a toilet like the one recently constructed. To date, there’s still joy in their hearts and on their faces for the very first toilet project ever built not only in Sampoo but in their locality. The water well project also built by NCM in the Sampoo community in 2020, was a milestone for the people of the Bom community.

As of today, there has been a serious reduction of deaths in the community because of the safe drinking water well. More to that, many people like the Sherbro, Mende, Krim, Bullion, the Muslims and the Bom people are getting saved through the projects and the CPs regular outreaches. According to the chief, who is a former Muslim now Christian, is thankful for the projects NCM has done for them free of charge, which he said no one has ever done for them since the foundation of Sampoo. To date, many Muslims that were not willing to listen to the Christian Gospel or have anything to do with Christians before are now becoming believers because of the love of God through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We pray that NCM sees the great need of safe drinking water wells and toilets in other Bom Communities in the Republic of Sierra Leone.” Patrick, NCM Coordinator Sierra Leone.



RELIEF PROJECTS

FIRST AND SECOND QUARTER

► TIGRAY RELIEF PROJECT IN ETHIOPIA

The Tigray Relief Project was done for the Azebu unengaged people group and the people of Adigrat. This project supported 600+ internally displaced people with food and basic necessities for one month!




“Shire is one of the most affected areas of Tigray. Out of the 1.7 million Internally displaced persons in Tigray region more than half of them are in Shire. The population is about 100,000 but we host more than 700,000 IDPs. The numbers say everything. The human rights issues, humanitarian crisis and security issues. Many of the Eritrean troops live in Shire – looting, killing and human rights abuses are common. The support we received from NCM we distributed to 20 households. Each household received 1000 Birr. In this difficult time this support means a lot. We also supported the orphans who live with us in the church compound.”

“Shire was the war front. There has been a lot of fighting here. Many thousands of people have been killed, wounded and displaced. Although we passed through difficulties, hunger and worries we didn’t lose anyone from our church and we give thanks to the Lord our protector. We shared what we have with the community. We have partners and supporters who pray and share resources with us. We have clearly seen the hand of the Lord.”

“We would like to thank you for your support during the war time. Although you didn’t get any information, you didn’t stop your support. Through your help we managed to save human lives. The church showed it’s love for the people.”

▶ FOOD RELIEF PROJECT AMONG THE HAMAR AND DASSANECH OF SOUTH OMO ETHIOPIA

“We have received 250 bags of corn and distributed them to more than 600 people including church planters. Three people groups of the Omo Valley have benefited from the relief. We thank all the organizations and individuals who participated in this great relief project.”



“We representatives from New Covenant Missions and Horn of Africa arrived at Turmi/ Hammer after two days of traveling. On May 13th, 2021 we gathered the people in the Turmi Kalehiwot church compound and explained the reason for our outreach in South Omo. Later we presented the Good News to the community and more than 100 people heard the Gospel.

They are happy about the things happening in their midst. People who viewed the Gospel being for the poor alone realized its triumphal power. Some individuals from wealthy and respected families received the Lord as their personal Savior. The attitude which undermines believers is now changing.” **NCM CP Nahom**



► FOOD RELIEF PROJECT IN UGANDA

“Due to a drought the Mening people of Uganda are having a serious food security issue. Raiders from South Sudan have invaded and stolen their cattle as well. They had no choice, but to hunt rats for food. NCM has launched a relief project to provide food for hundreds of families in dire need.”

THE IMPACT OF OUR FOOD RELIEF PROJECT

- Hungry families who had not eaten reasonable food for close to a year were able to have something to cook for the first time.
- The Mening have been able to see Jehovah Jireh as the only provider during their troubled times. The Lord has glorified himself among the Mening.
- Finally there was a big harvest during the distribution. Of the hundred households that received, 41 were able to confess Jesus as Lord and savior of their lives.



“Praise Jesus! I am Anne from the Mening community. Allow me to thank God for his provision of food to the hunger stricken Mening community through New Covenant Missions. It had been a difficult moment for us right from last year as there were no rains due to the changes in the seasonal patterns. Amidst all this, we want to thank the administration of NCM for responding immediately to our request when we wrote to them, explaining the challenges we were facing. May the Almighty God continue to replenish and bless you abundantly for the continuous support, as we expand Gods kingdom amongst these unreached peoples groups.”

► **FOOD RELIEF PROJECT
AMONG THE GARRE OF ETHIOPIA**



2021 was a challenging year for Ethiopia. Ethnic conflict, drought, and COVID-19 restrictions caused incredible suffering for the Garre people. They lost their livelihood sources such as livestock, crops and small animals. As a result the NCM initiated to support the people who are the poorest of poor. In November and December 2021, our church planters in this area were distributing essential food items for the community. Terefe and Boku have been physically involved in the process. They were not only distributing essential food items for the Garre people, but they also preached the Good News of Jesus Christ. **200 families benefited with a months worth of food and 300 people heard the Gospel!**



After they finished the distribution, the church planters prayed to God to give them rain. Amazingly it rained and the people were happy. That was a great breakthrough for the mission activities in this strict Muslim community.

Summary of the food items: 20 kg of rice for each household, 5 kg of wheat powder, 4 liters of oil, 5 kg sugar

► **COVID-19 RELIEF**

We reached out to 445 families spread between Senegal, Chad, & Gambia. They were supplied with sanitation supplies during the second wave of COVID-19 and 250 of the poorest families were provided with one month supply of food.



► VOLCANO VICTIMS RELIEF PROJECT IN EDRC

On May 22, 2021, Mt. Nyiragongo erupted and spit out lava that came just under two miles from reaching the Goma Airport in Eastern D.R. Congo. In its path, homes were destroyed and buried with lava. Main roads in and out the city were cut off along with the loss of electricity. There are now over 4500 families who are homeless and without the basics of life. Many of the affected families do not have a relationship with the one true God and live in fear.

"The 50 church members who are living with the host families thank God for those who thought to buy soap and food for them. They are assisting the volcano victims who will be the next beneficiaries. To God be the glory!"

Thanks to your contributions, families that have been displaced have started to receive the help they need. Not only have they begun to receive food and supplies, but they have also begun to hear the love that God truly has for them.

► NIGERIA

Without a school uniform, children are often denied education in Africa. For many families, a uniform is equivalent to more than a month's wages. Without education, children are 50% more likely to be sold off to traffickers. 90 children in Nigeria were able to attend school this year as NCM teams provided uniforms and other school supplies!

(First primary school - 45 pupils, second primary school - 25 pupils, third primary school - 20 pupils. Total number of pupils given uniforms - 90 pupils.)

"We had a total of sixty-three students registered the beginning of 2021."

What degrees and/or certificates are the students working towards?

"We offer 1) Certificate in Ministerial Studies. It covers six courses (Evangelism, Discipleship, Cross-Cultural Missions, Cross-Cultural Church Planting, Pastoral, and Leadership,) covering eighteen credits. 2) Bachelor of Arts in Bible and Theology. This runs for four years, covering 128 credits."

What countries are represented?

"The nine countries represented are Liberia, Sierra Leone, Ghana, Nigeria, DRC, Congo Brazzaville, Kenya, Uganda, and CAR."

LIBERIA- *"My name is Rev. Mrs. Jonel Clark Weeks of Victory Outreach Central Church in Monrovia, Liberia. I am a student of the NCIU campus. I am overwhelmed with joy for this blessing afforded many of us believers to gain biblical insights and knowledge through our dynamic professors and detailed courses offered. In these few semesters, I have learned that a pastor is not just a preacher, but a steward, a manager, a servant, an overseer, a man or woman that should live above reproach. The Gospel of John, Cross-Cultural Evangelism, Church Planting, Missions and Pastoral Theology courses have broaden my scope of ideas on Evangelism. I'm also applying the idea from the methods of Closure taught in Cross-Cultural Church Planting in many events in my personal life. I am so happy and grateful I now know as a good leader I must train, nurture and mentor others."*

GHANA- *"I am Rev. Samson Sansah Bona-Imah from Ghana, a student of NCIU/ NCSOM. I'm a level 100 student. NCIU/ NCSOM is a School where true Bible doctrine is taught with qualified lecturers and is preparing students in Africa to relate and work with all ethnic groups in Africa. I can testify that the School has prepared me to work wherever I'm sent as a missionary."*

NIGERIA- *"My name is Ismaila Destiny Kadiri from Nigeria, a student of NCSOM. I must confess, by having the privilege of gaining admission into this Academy, it's been a life transforming experience for me, as I'm being equipped with new methods and better ways to serve the Lord, especially as a missionary. As one of the pioneer students, I strongly believe this school to be a heavenly arrangement under the watch of Sydney B. Thomas; the chief academic officer who has been working tirelessly to ensure the full success of the programs. His organization and coordinating style; the demonstration of his patience and love and the fervency of his faith are not far from the reason this is working and these are also some virtues I'm opportune to learn as a young student in the vineyard of Christ. It's been a wonderful journey of sound spiritual impartation, which I believe will have a successful end that will add value to the Body of Christ, especially in Africa."*

D.R. CONGO- *"I, Leon Dede have learned from NCSOM how to depict truth from the Bible, while dealing with the Gospel of John with Jeff Hundley. Global Alliance for Church Multiplication connects us in partnership with ministries like ours so we can go further together.


