


DO Utiel-Requena is a small plateau in the interior of the province of **Valencia**, at 70 kms from the mediterranean sea and 700 meters above sea level with a surface of vineyards of 40.000 hectares. The land has Mediterranean characteristics but continental influences, being the local autochthon grape the BOBAL and GARNACHA TINTORERA, both used in our wines.

BOBAL on a 2.500 years old lberian cellar:

Bodegas Vegalfaro

Bordering our vineyards a cellar 3000 years old has been recently discover, demonstrating that our vineyards have been producing wines since then.

From the situation of our vineyards on the hill of the picture, by gravity they used to send the grapes to the pressing stone and the again down the hill to ferment and stock the wine in TERRACOTA AMPHORAE.

From there, they were sent by the river CABRIEL to the mediterranean sea for export to other civilizations. Our wine name CAPRASIA comes from that river.

A wonder of the Iberian civilization in the National Natural Park Hoces del Cabriel.

ORGANIC WINES made in AMPHORAE

Inheriting the tradition of producing wines as Iberian used to do without pesticides and chemicals, our cellar only produces ORGANIC wines with 3 local varieties BOBAL, GARNACHA TINTORERA (also known as Alicante Bouschet) and TEMPRANILLO together with Syrah and Merlot.

Our BOBAL wine also stays during 5 months in TERRACOTA AMPHORAE, so you can experience a wine as close as possible as the Iberian used to drink it.














REBEL.LIA

Tempranillo, Garnacha Tintorera and Bobal Organic young wine, 4 months in barrel

Dark black cherry hue. Good intense nose and predominant strong red fruits, soft toasted notes. Fresh in the mouth, laced with gentle tannins and good acidity. Long in the mouth, very pleasant finish.








CAPRASIA WHITE

55% Chardonnay, 45% Macabeo. Organic wine 3 months in French barrel

Clean, Bright straw-yellow color with subtle green flashes. Good intensity, mature pineapple, lemos bonbons and white flowers.

A clean attack producing a fresh sensation, excellent acidity, refreshing with a final, enticing bitter twist. Citrus and tropical fruits return in the aftertaste with a mineral tone.








CAPRASIA ROSÉ

55% Bobal 45% Merlot. Organic wine 40 days in French oak

Bright and salmon tone, with a strong perfume, reminds wild strawberries.

A long-lasting joyful flavor, with a pleasant acid balance








CAPRASIA ROBLE

55% Bobal, 45% Merlot. Organic wine 4-5 months in Hungarian barrels

Dark black cherry hue.

Good intense nose and predominant strong red fruits, soft toasted notes. Fresh in the mouth, laced with gentle tannins and good acidity. Long in the mouth, very pleasant finish.







CAPRASIA BOBAL

100% Bobal. Organic wine1 year in oak barrels and 5 months in in terracota amphorae

Very intense color, dark, ripe cherry. In the nose black fruits, chocolate, coffee notes from the well integrated oak. Chocolate in the mouth, finesse brought by the terracota barrels. Persistent.





PAGO DE LOS BALAGUESES

100% Chardonnay

Gained slightly yellow, gold highlights and tear-intensive. The nose is a mix of yellow fruti type and pretty mature with tropical notes of aging such as vanilla, pastries, fine woods, yeast, dairy... The palate has a sweet tooth with great smoothness entry, good acidity that gives some freshness, rather long aftertaste, very fruity and vanilla notes memories and lightly toasted.

PAGO DE LOS BALAGUESES

100% Syrah 14 months in barrel

Intense black cherry color with purple glints. Aromatic hints of fennel and aniseed fussed with ripe cherries, cream oak, toasted, complex chocolate and fruity expression. Strong in mouth, delicious, smooth and velvety. Long toasted depth.





PAGO DE LOS BALAGUESES

Garnacha Tintorera and Merlot 14 months in barrel

Deep cherry-red hue, medium high brilliant rim. Enjoys and intense bouquet of crips res and black fruit, freshly balsamic, evocking the lower slopes, aromatic herbs and deep. Delicious, soft on the palate. Liquorice aftertaste.

The cellar is located in the border of the National Park Hoces del Cabriel where a **2.500 years old Iberian cellar** was discovered. Our Caprasia Bobal is produced imitating the techniques used at that time, like growing local grapes, **aging in terracotta amphorae** and using **organic procedures**: the land, the winery and the production methods are all organic. Pesticides have never been used making the soil to be alive. The vineyard consists on **indigenous grapes** that have been growing in this lands for thousands of years. All these produces distinctive and attractive wines which are **continuously awarded.**
