This year we are very proud to say we will be running our first arts prize: 'The Real Bath Prize' open to anyone to interpret the wonderful city of Bath in an original way.

We actively promote and celebrate contemporary art in the Bath area and beyond, showcasing early career artists and curators, and those who find it difficult to break into (or prefer to operate outside of) the gallery based art scene. FAB frequently uses "alternative", temporary exhibition spaces - anything from street corners, shops and shopping centres to front rooms and cafés.

We are a not for profit organisation and receive little funding, relying on enthusiastic volunteers to enable us to put on each year's programme of shows and events.

**Read the requirements in each call out.** It is free to submit work and proposals, if you are selected then there will be a £10 administration charge per artist (this charge does not apply to events 2,8,9,11); this will go towards publicity and other costs incurred during the festival. FAB is a voluntary, not for profit organisation, and a company limited by guarantee.
