In 2005, Dr. Madaiah Revana discovered a rare piece of land tucked along the northwestern limit of the Dundee Hills AVA that in less than fifteen years has been recognized two times in Wine Spectator's Top 100 Wines of the World.

Alexana Estate is a 55-acre dry-farmed, mid-slope vineyard that has become recognized as one of the wine world's most geologically diverse sites, with its 18 different soil types. The vineyard is planted by soil type into 29 small blocks of Pinot noir, 2 blocks of Chardonnay and a singular block of Pinot gris. All are triple hand-sorted to the individual berry prior to fermentation. Winemaker Tresider Burns takes the meticulous approach of fermenting each vineyard block discretely to produce classically beautiful wines that are unique to the personality of this tiny pocket of the Willamette Valley.

In 2020, Dr. Revana purchased the neighboring 'Kinney Ridge' property and has since developed a 45-acre vineyard, nearly contiguous to the Revana Vineyard at Alexana. These additional plantings continue to build on the Revana Portfolio's pursuit of excellence through its work with outstanding vineyards across the globe.

The first vines were planted at Antica Terra in 1989 in a clearing within the oak savannah, yet today, the oldest vines look like infants. By being planted in a solid sheet of rock -- a fractured mixture of sandstone sown with 40-million-year-old marine fossils -- they have become, quite literally, bonsai-ed. Instead of the gnarled trunks and robust canes one expects from vines planted over three decades ago, these are almost comically undersized, demanding the most exacting attention and care. In return, they offer us the opportunity to make good on the promise we made to ourselves and to this site when we arrived: to gain on intimacy, to perfect and refine our farming over time, to be stewards worthy of this piece of land, and the work of those that came before us.

Apolloni Vineyards is a family-owned and operated estate property showcasing cool-climate varieties, including Pinot noir, Pinot gris, Pinot blanc and Chardonnay. Alfredo's winemaking tradition dates back over 150 years, with family vineyards in northern Italy. He and his wife, Laurine, established the vineyard in 1999 so that their children could grow up sharing in the family tradition. The vineyards and winery are LIVE certified, encompassing 45 acres planted on Laurelwood soils, tucked up against the foothills of the Coast Range forest with sweeping views of the Range. The wines produced are distinctive: made with a gentle hand and restraint, as an authentic reflection of place and vintage.

Bethel Heights Vineyard was established in 1977 in the Eola-Amity Hills by Ted Casteel, Terry Casteel, Pat Dudley and Marilyn Webb. In 2006, Ben Casteel took the helm as second-generation winemaker. Over the years the estate vineyard has grown to 80 acres, now including the adjacent Justice Vineyard and Lewman Vineyard, but the original 50 acres of own-rooted Pinot noir and Chardonnay vines planted in the '70s still define the essential character of Bethel Heights wines.

Gnarly old vines, geologically complex hillside soils, and direct impact from Æolian winds all conspire to create highly energized wines with firm backbones, depth of character and distinctive personalities. Fourteen different bottlings of estate grown Pinot noir and Chardonnay each year barely begin to tell the tale.

Brittan Vineyards was founded by winemaker Robert Brittan and his wife Ellen, who left Napa Valley to pursue their dream of making cool-climate Pinot noir and Chardonnay in Oregon. In 2004, the Brittans purchased their 128-acre property in the foothills of the Coast Range in the McMinnville AVA, where they have 24.5 acres planted to Pinot noir, 4 acres to Chardonnay and 1.5 acres to Syrah. Now in his fiftieth vintage, Robert brings extensive viticultural and winemaking experience to their venture, having worked as winemaker at Far Niente, St. Andrew's and Stags' Leap Winery before heading north to the Willamette Valley. On his rocky, exposed hillside Robert has found a vineyard site that allows him to craft wines that speak of a unique place. The Pinot noirs from the estate vineyard are intense, rich wines that have great structure, yet are balanced, elegant and age-worthy.

Bryn Mawr Vineyards was purchased by Jon and Kathy Lauer in 2009 as a tiny garage winery, with a four-acre foundation of established Pinot noir, Chardonnay and Tempranillo vines. The Lauer family partnered with dynamic winemaker Rachel Rose to diversify the site, adding Pinot blanc, Dolcetto and Riesling vines among many new clones of the regional standards. For the first eight vintages, Rachel, armed with degrees in microbiology, enology, and viticulture, made wine in the Lauer's basement and a rented wedding tent. In 2018, we completed our new winery facility, followed by a new tasting room in 2019. The last decade has brought national recognition for Bryn Mawr's Pinot noir and Chardonnay programs, but it's our playful, experimental side that has made us a local destination. Acting as an important bridge, Bryn Mawr honors the wines that make the Willamette Valley world-renowned while pushing the envelope and defining what is possible in our future. Rachel's winemaking is adaptive, experimental, and extremely judicious in its use of oak and sulphur, allowing each wine from our edgy estate to be its own unique character.

In January of 1965, Eyrie founder David Lett arrived in Oregon with 3,000 grapevine cuttings and a theory. 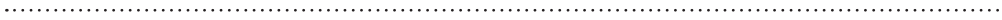

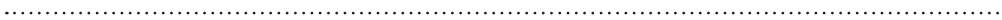

Intrigued by the potential of the microclimate and its ability to produce evocative Pinot noir, Carl and Marilyn Thoma were among the first to choose the foothills at the mouth of the Van Duzer Corridor to build their family estate in 1998. Perched atop a knoll and surrounded by vines, the site is situated in the gateway of the Corridor—a deep gap in the Coast Range that draws brisk air from the Pacific Ocean into the Willamette Valley. These tempering breezes moderate vineyard conditions, keeping the site warmer in cool vintages and maintaining lower temperatures in warm years. Resulting circumstances are ideal for optimal sugar accumulation and balancing acidity, as well as a long, beneficial growing season year after year.
