

HOWARD WEISS is the Concertmaster of the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra. Prior to that he was a member of the Cleveland Orchestra, and has also been the Concertmaster of the San Francisco Ballet, the Virginia Symphony, and the Chicago Chamber Orchestra. He has appeared as soloist with many orchestras, including the Rochester Philharmonic, the Cleveland Orchestra and the New Orleans Philharmonic. A native of Chicago, Mr. Weiss was a member of the Youth Orchestra of Greater Chicago, and feels that such an experience is valuable to the development of a young musician.

NICK BAKER, a senior at the School Without Walls, has been principal bassoon of the RPYO for 2 years and a member for 3 years. He has studied bassoon for 3 years with Abraham Weiss, of the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra and he has played the bassoon for a total of 6 years. Nick is a Regents Scholarship winner and he won the Brockport Young Artists Award in March, 1974. As winner of this year's Eisenhart Award, he appeared as soloist with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra on May 24, 1974, performing a concerto by Vivaldi. Next fall, Nick will enter Eastman as a bassoon major.

ANNE TWEET, a senior at Penfield High, is a charter member of the RPYO and was appointed assistant concertmaster this year. She has played violin for 10 years and has been a student of Howard Weiss for the past 3 years. She is a Regents Scholarship winner, a member of the National Honor Society, and has a 3.9 scholastic average. In September, Anne will enter Brown University majoring in Archaeology.

SUE COLE, a senior at Fairport High, has been a member of the RPYO for 3 years and became principal horn this year. She has played the horn for 8 years, all of that time as a student of Munro Sherrill. She is a Regents Scholarship alternate, a member of the National Honor Society, and a winner of the Rotary Award for Musical Achievement. Last summer, Sue attended the Saratoga School of Orchestral Studies maintained by the Philadelphia Orchestra. In addition, she is listed in "Who's Who in American High School Students." Next fall, she will enter Eastman as a horn major.

The RPYO is completing its 4th full season under the sponsorship of The Women's Committee of the CMA. Howard Weiss, the concertmaster of the R.P.O. has been Music Director of the group since its inception. Under his direction the RPYO has grown to 95 members and has presented six concerts this past season. At least one member of the orchestra, selected by audition, appears as soloist with the R.P.Y.O. at each of its concerts.

On December 3, 1972, the RPYO was the featured high school orchestra at the Annual New York State School Music Association Convention, performing in the Eastman Theatre for 2,000 New York State music educators. A recording made at this concert rapidly sold out.

Last month the RPYO appeared with the RPO in a series of 3 educational concerts at the Eastman Theatre before 9,000 elementary school children. They also appeared for a repeat evening performance for a membership concert for CMA.

The purpose of the RPYO is to further enrich the musical education of talented young musicians and to introduce them to the outstanding orchestral masterpieces at as early an age as possible, thereby providing them with the challenge and incentive for further study. Membership in the orchestra is drawn from the Greater Rochester area with 35 schools represented in this year's orchestra. Alumni of the orchestra are currently students at several music schools including Eastman, Juilliard, Indiana University at Bloomington, the Cleveland Institute of Music, Peabody in Baltimore, the Royal College in London, England, and the Mozarteum in Salzburg, Austria.

Membership in the Rochester Philharmonic Youth Orchestra is open to any qualified young person, twelve to eighteen years of age. With 30 seniors graduating, we expect openings in every section of the orchestra except tuba. The rehearsals are on Sunday afternoons from 2:00 to 5:00 P.M. at Monroe Community College. 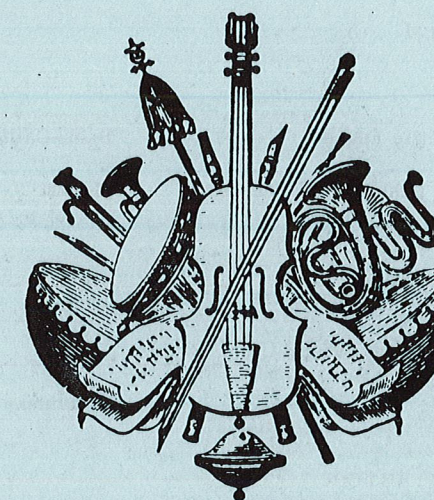
