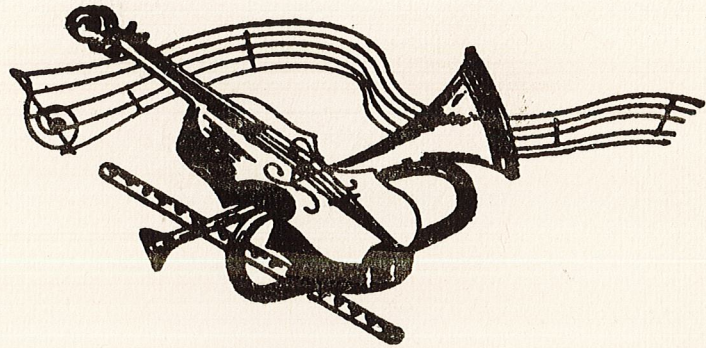

The orchestra members represent forty-one schools in the greater Rochester area, grades seven through twelve.

HOWARD WEISS, Concertmaster of the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra, was a member of the Cleveland Orchestra and Concertmaster of the San Francisco Ballet, the Virginia Symphony and the Chicago Chamber Orchestra. He has appeared as soloist with many of the major orchestras and is a regular participant at the Casals Festival in San Juan, Puerto Rico. Since 1976, Mr. Weiss has been Concertmaster of the Eastern Music Festival in Greensboro, North Carolina and has performed chamber music with Leonard Rose, Jaime Laredo, Walter Trampler and Lynn Harrell. Mr. Weiss is an alumnus of the Youth Orchestra of Greater Chicago, and recognizes the value of the experience.

NOTES

For ten years the RPYO has pursued its goal of enriching the musical education of talented young musicians. The orchestra has performed outstanding orchestral works at joint concerts with the RPO, at its own winter and spring concerts and, for the past three years, on tours to New England, Florida, and South Carolina. In spring of 1978 the RPYO made a recording of a very special performance of the Symphony No. 1 by Sibelius at Van Wezel Hall in Sarasota, Florida. The latest recording, recently released, was made in January 1979 of the Shostokovich Symphony No. 5.

One of the objectives of the RPYO has always been to afford the opportunity for at least one member of the orchestra to appear as a soloist at each concert. The orchestra has also premiered compositions written and dedicated to the RPYO by two of its own members.

Alumni of the RPYO already hold significant positions in major orchestras and principal positions in such orchestras as the Atlanta Symphony, National Symphony of Costa Rica, the Syracuse Symphony, the Pittsburgh Symphony, the Vancouver Symphony and the symphonies of Maracaibo and Caracas, Venezuela.
