### Food security in Lotumbe

- Animal husbandry training and vaccinations for ducks, goats, cows. Cost: USD 38,000/AUD 49,582
- Beekeeping training on commercialization of honey. Cost: USD 3300/AUD 4245
- Citrus trees to fight malnutrition and poverty through fruit sales while reforesting the environment and combating climate change. Cost: USD 3.10/AUD 4
- Duck raising to sell eggs that pay for orphans' school tuition and improve nutrition. Cost: USD 5.50/AUD 7
- Cassava grinding machine to help village women save time and produce more items to sell at markets. Cost: USD 5000/AUD 6432
- Purchasing a 100mx2 plot for a market garden and garden tools for widows and single mums. Cost: USD 200/AUD 258

### Education in Lotumbe

- Books for Lotumbe's 7 schools, enhancing education for 1000 + students and their teachers. Cost for one book: USD 10/AUD 12

- Stipends for 3 pre-school teachers who receive no other funding, and who provide essential day care for the children of working parents. Cost: USD 300/AUD 386
- Tuition for one orphan. Cost: USD 40/AUD 52
- Wheelchair for disabled students: USD 500/AUD 645
- Handwashing station per school (there are 7): USD 35/AUD 47

- Sewing supplies so that washable feminine hygiene kits can be provided to girl students, keeping them in school. Cost: USD 5/AUD 6.50
