Dear Parents/Carers

Although the Autumn Term is still in full flow, we are already busy making preparations for the first week back in January to ensure that all pupils enjoy a safe and effective start back to school. In order to ensure that the reopening of schools is as safe as possible following the Christmas break, the government has produced very detailed guidance regarding the 'system controls' that schools should ensure are in place to minimise the risk of transmission of coronavirus. The latest guidance stipulates that school's should once again create capacity to administer Asymptomatic Lateral Flow Testing which will help to identify pupils who are infectious but do not have any coronavirus symptoms.

At Redhill School, we are in a strong position as our testing site has operated several times very successfully. The testing operatives that we have employed are well trained, experienced and are well versed in ensuring that the testing experience is as pleasant as possible.

The government has stated that;

- All pupils will receive one test and if they receive a negative result then they can be admitted to school.
- Schools have once again been given the flexibility to stagger the return for pupils to allow the testing to take place.
- The tests are voluntary but we support the government position and strongly encourage that you consent to your child participating in order to contribute to the overall effectiveness of the control measure.
- If pupils do not consent to testing they will be readmitted with the rest of their year group.

In response to the guidance we have devised a phased return process which will enable us to test pupils safely and effectively. This is outlined below and includes the dates that each year group will be tested. On the day of their test <u>pupils must only attend for their test and then return</u> <u>home</u>. Pupils may attend the test in their own clothes.

Our testing site will be set up in our Gymnasium and pupils will be tested in form tutor groups for their tests on the days specified on the next page. If a pupil tests positive for coronavirus on a lateral flow test then they will need to book a PCR test and self-isolate for 10 days in line with the guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection. If a pupil tests negative, then they will return to school the following day in line with our staggered start arrangements.

As there is a staggered start to the school year, we will be providing Online Learning from Wednesday 5th January for all year groups to access. Further details on this will be communicated later this week.
