EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Entry Period

EOIs will open on Monday 12 February 2018
EOIs will close at 12 midnight on Sunday 11 March 2018

Entry restrictions

EOIs will only be accepted from Northern Rivers residents.

Entry method

EOIs must be submitted via the online form available at the project website.
EOIs must address all questions in the online form.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Selection Panel

The selection panel will consist of industry experts including:

- Lisa Havilah - Director, Carriageworks
- Roslyn Helper - Director, Underbelly Arts
- Jeff Khan - Artistic Director, Performance Space

Arts Northern Rivers will contribute to the selection process however the selection panel will make the final decision.

Criteria

The selection criteria will be based on the following considerations

- Creativity and innovation of the proposed project
- Potential benefits to be gained from receiving the project development package.
- Potential of the proposed project to attract funding

Finalist Selection Process

At the conclusion of the EOI period, Arts Northern Rivers will shortlist applicants.

Shortlist

Up to 5 shortlisted applicants will meet with ANR to discuss and develop their Big Idea further.

Meeting Date: 20 or 21 March

Big Idea development

Shortlisted applicants will develop their Big Idea proposal to be assessed by the selection panel.

Return to ANR: 28 March 2017

Selection Process

Final proposals will be assessed by the selection panel. The finalists will be invited to meet the selection panel on Tuesday 10 April.

Each finalist will have an opportunity to 'pitch' their proposal to the selection panel.

Following the pitching process the panel will select one successful applicant.

Result Notification

The successful applicant will be announced at a panel session and networking event to be held on the evening of Tuesday 10 April.

PACKAGE

The project development package will include access to the ANR team with the aim of developing your project proposal to grant-ready stage.

Strategic planning sessions may include (but are not limited to) the following:

- 4 x 2 hour strategic planning sessions with Arts Northern Rivers between the (16 April and 16 July)
- Exploration of possible funding opportunities
- Identification of potential project partners (where appropriate)
- Connection with industry experts to offer assistance and input into the development of the project idea
- Input into budget development for the proposed project
- Assistance with preparation of grant application(s)
- Feedback on final drafts of grant applications

PACKAGE RESTRICTIONS

- Unless otherwise specified ANR will not be responsible for any additional costs associated with the package.
- The successful applicant will be responsible for the submission of the grant application.
- ANR are not responsible for managing the project if successful.
- The successful applicant must be available and willing to commit to date's stipulated by ANR. If the applicants are not able to fulfil requirements, ANR may determine another successful applicant in its absolute discretion.
