

# Gallica Cabernet Sauvignon 2011 Napa Valley

**Score 17.5/20**

*96% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Petit Verdot, 1% Cabernet Franc. 19 months in 70% new French oak. Cool vintage (more so than 2010).*

Lighter and more nimble-footed than the 2010, but with the same delicious herby note as well as cassis and black cherry fruit. Gorgeously tender tannic feel and staunchly savoury finish. (RH)
