

Gallica Cabernet Sauvignon 2010 Napa Valley

Score 18/20

83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, 7% Petit Verdot. 19 months in 78% new French oak. Cooler vintage than 2009.

Interesting leafy notes here, which gives greater interest and complexity to the nose than the 2009, yet there is tremendously rich fruit in support too. Finishes with seriously savoury notes. Sophisticated and rich and delicious. (RH)
