Under the authority of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1701 et. seq.) and pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.2, the following fire prevention orders are issued. These orders are in addition to prohibited acts found in 43 CFR 9212.1.

State and Local Laws

In the interest of Wildfire Prevention, Public Safety, and in compliance with 43 CFR 9212.2 requiring Bureau of Land Management actions to complement and support state and local Wildfire Prevention, all state and local Wildfire Prevention Laws and Regulations shall apply to all Bureau of Land Management lands within the State of Nevada.

Acts Restricted by Fire Prevention Order


On all public lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management within the State of Nevada, unless otherwise authorized in writing, the following actions are prohibited:

- **Building a campfire, warming, or cooking fire without a minimum of 6 feet clear of vegetation or burnable materials. The fire must be attended at all times and extinguished when not in use.**
- **Smoking in an area clear of dry or non-burnable vegetation. Smoking materials must be extinguished and disposed of properly when not in use.**

Possession of shovel, fire extinguisher and/or at least 5 gallons of water should be on hand in the event of an unintentional fire start.

Title 43 CFR 9212.0-5, 9212.1 and 9212.4 wildfire prevention provides that any person who knowingly and willfully performs any act restricted by a Fire Prevention Order, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000 or to imprisonment of not more than 12 months or both. Restitution for total suppression and damage costs incurred will be borne by the trespasser.

This Fire Prevention Order will remain in effect from April 15, 2020 until rescinded or replaced.
