Facility Update:

The Gas Operations team continues to monitor and make field adjustments where necessary on the well field. The gas team is monitoring the wells multiple times a month and is investigating specific wells that may be contributing to the recent odors. The monitoring at the High Acres Landfill exceeds what is required by state and federal regulation. High Acres is only required to test each well once a month, but we are committed to resolving the recent odor nuisance and to do so, the team is going above and beyond the requirements to ensure that they are maximizing the gas collection. In the recent weeks, High Acres has employed the help of other gas technicians from surrounding Waste Management facilities to help with the monitoring and data collection.

Recently, we have installed 15 well boots to maximize the efficiency of designated vertical wells. The installation of 2 new horizontal well collectors will begin around the beginning of November in our Cell 10 area. The installation of these wells is for the early gas collection and nuisance odor control and precedes any federal regulatory requirements. Additionally, we are exceeding regulatory requirements by utilizing other forms of technology that is not required to help resolve this matter.
