## **Business Arising from the Minutes:**

# Covid-19:

- ~We will continue to encourage remote or on-line connection for those who are unable to meet current health safety measures.
- ~Posters indicating current health safety expectations for in-person services will be posted on the inside and outside of all 3 main doors.
- ~Sacred Grounds will be asked to check the fan direction as a possible alternative to open doors in providing ventilation.
- ~Phyllis has been provided with a note for rental groups, advising them of their responsibility to ensure current BC Health guidelines are followed.

#### AGM:

- ~For 2020, there has been no requirement set by Pacific Mountain Region regarding whether an annual meeting must take place. However, it was agreed that PRUC would hold their meeting in the sanctuary during the worship service of October 17th. Congregants will be encouraged to bring their lunch. (There will be no shared food.) The annual report has already been circulated; the meeting will allow time for questions about the reports, approve the reports, and affirm additions to the Navigation Team and M&P.

It was noted that the total Year-to-Date deficit would be more than \$26,000 if not for the federal subsidies and the staff cut-backs. This does not include the deficits being incurred to continue our very valuable *Communications* and *Young Families* projects.
