Thank you for your interest in the captivating craft of lampwork glass beadmaking!

Before you let fire inspire at the workshop, please consider the following:

- If you have long hair, or hair which falls across your face, please tie it back.
- Please wear closed shoes.
Sandals and bare feet are not appropriate footwear in a hot-glass environment.
- Please don't wear your best clothes.
Hot glass can present a risk to clothing.
I can lend you an apron to wear if you'd like.

The workshop is a safe environment in which to work, and on your arrival you will be made aware of the safety considerations to bear in mind during your course.

When you are working at the torch flame, I am a firm believer that there is no 'wrong', if.....
...you are safe
...you are comfortable
...and the way you are working is working for you

If you find alternative approaches to your work at the torch flame that work better for you than the way I have shown you, and the three criteria above are all met – then go for it! Every artist is different – and that's absolutely fine.

I can say with some confidence that the hardest part of a beadmaking course is choosing which colours to use for which bead!

Relax, enjoy yourself, and have a wonderful journey into this exciting art form.
