Accepted Items

Bedroom

- Beds all sizes EXCEPT KINGSIZE (mattresses / box springs, headboards and frames)
- Freshly cleaned bedding and linens
- Dressers

- Curtains and rods (5 yrs. or newer)

Bathroom

- Towels
- Facecloths
- Bath mats
- New or well cleaned shower curtains and hooks



Kitchen and dining room

- Kitchen and dining room tables
- Chairs (kitchen, dining, office)
- Serving carts
- Small appliances that are clean and in good working order
- Complete sets (min 4 of each) of plates, cups, saucers, bowls
- serving dishes/bowls forks, knives, spoons
- Kitchen utensils
- Pots and pans
- Serving dishes and new Tupperware
- Buffets / sideboard / hutches (maximum size 48 " x 24")
- Tablecloths and placemats

Living Room

- Couches / sofas / loveseats
- Armchairs and ottomans
- Book cases / shelving units

- Televisions newer flat screen all sizes (we do not take older tube televisions)
- DVD players (working)

Items we are unable to accept *

- Any item that smells of mould

- Worn furniture with rips, tears, stains, or visible pet hair
- Baby items (high chairs, cribs, strollers, carriages, boosters, car seats, clothes, etc.)
- Barbecues
- Specialty beds (hospital beds, steel spring beds, futons without a frame and waterbeds) **
- Books, CDs, video tapes
- Holiday decorations, and ornaments
- Clothing
- Bicycles **
- Floor model TVs, stereos, and VCRs
- Unassembled furniture and shelving
- Oversized shelving units and metal shelving
- Major appliances (stoves, fridges, freezers, dishwashers, washers and dryers, etc.) **
