

KB-NSW Freestyle Competition



Have you got what it takes to do the most free style tricks on Jervis Bay and claim the award of the NSW Freestyle Kiteboarding Champion?

NSW Freestyle Kiteboarding competition is an opportunity for the free style kite boarders to cut loose and show off their best tricks and skills. This event is being judged from shore by judges on technical ability, difficulty, and who demonstrates they are the best free styler on the water. If you can do basic spins/rolls, kite loops, board-offs, handle passes, grabs, transitions and other free style tricks on a board, come and show Huskisson your stuff.

There is going to be an official heat start and finish. A heat is under way while its colour flag is flying. The heat is ended when its flag is removed and the next heat starts when its colour flag goes up.

There will be an award and bragging rights for: 1st place in each division.

Skill Level: Confident kite boarder, ability to perform hooked and unhooked tricks safely.

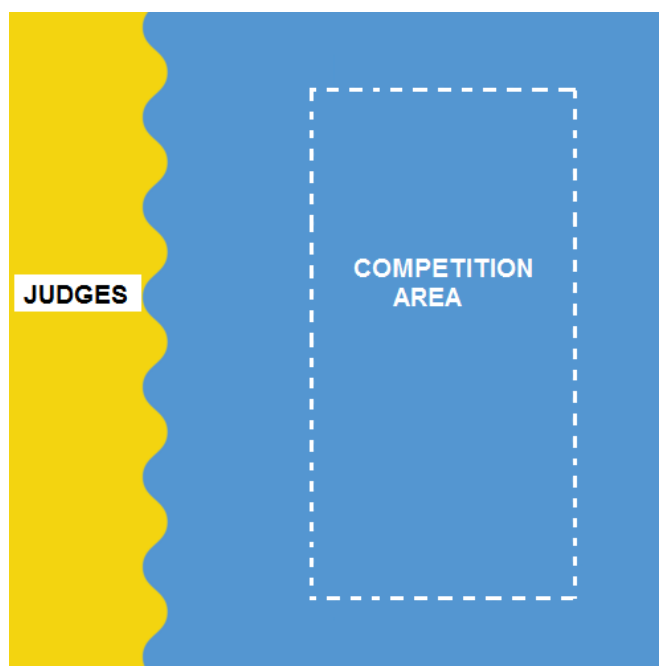
Tracking / Scoring: Bibs with numbers. KB-NSW judges.

Safety: All the following items are recommended to be worn helmet, buoyancy aid, kite knife and wetsuit.

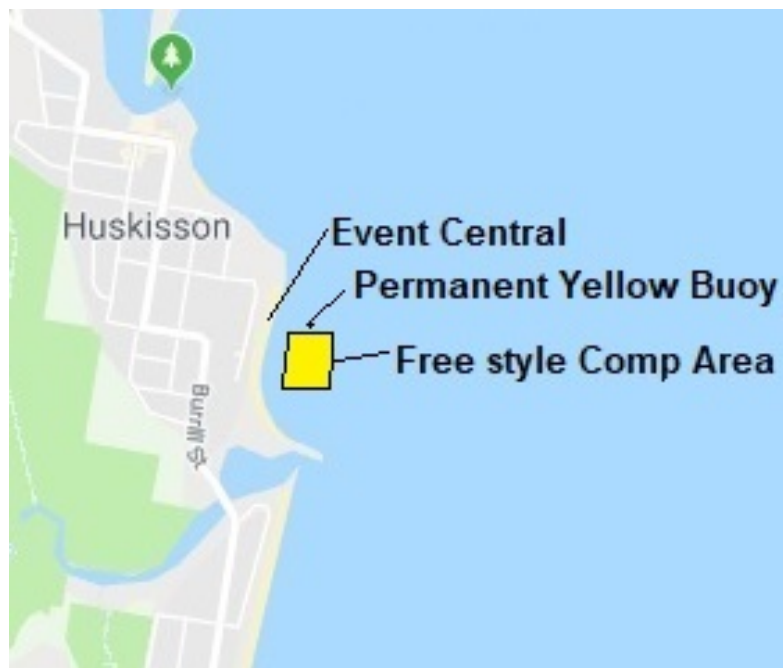
Support: This is a self-rescue event.

Comments:

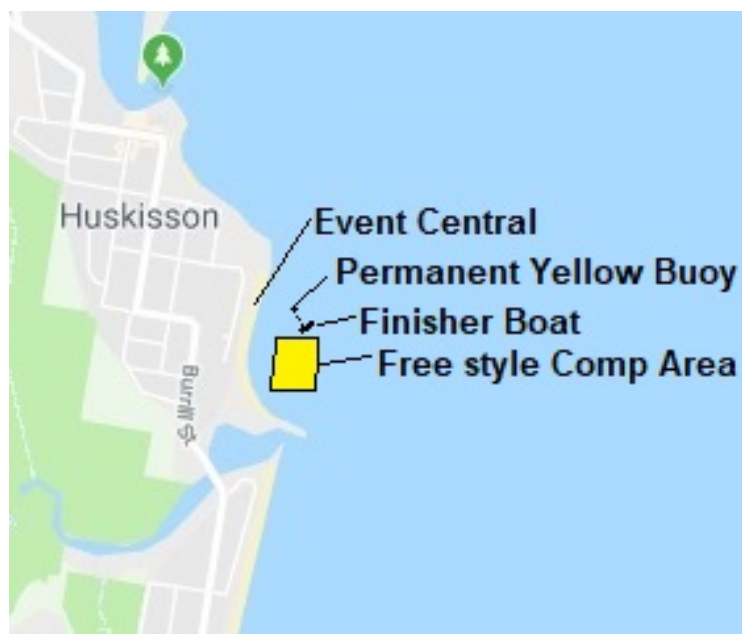
- Kite fee stylers will be scored only in the competition area.
- Kite fee stylers are allowed to use any equipment or apparatus, (there are no restrictions).
- Kite fee stylers should not land or perform tricks on the beach or within 6m of the water's edge.
- Kite fee stylers are to abide by the KBA Right of Ways and free style etiquette.
- Judges award each kite fee stylers tricks points on a scale from 1 to 10 in increments of 1/10th of a point.
- Judges analyse and score tricks based on technical difficulty and risk factor.
- Capsizing, grabbing the safety leash, crashing the kite, sinking, and landing on your back will be considered crashes by the judges.
- Crashes to be scored 0 points and counted as an attempt.
- Disregarding Right of Way's or poor etiquette are to be scored 0 points and counted as an attempt

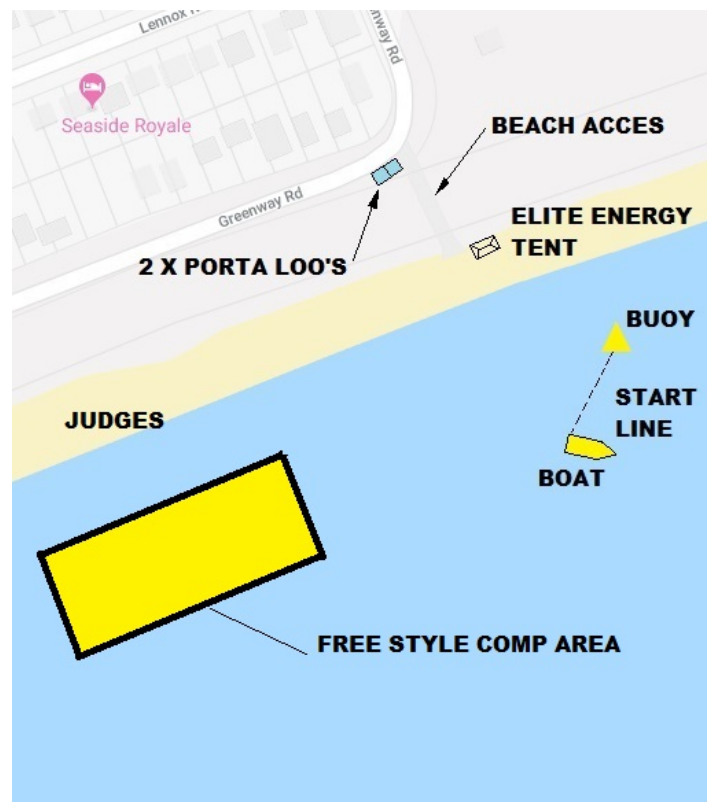


Huskisson Beach Free Style Area (Saturday afternoon):
