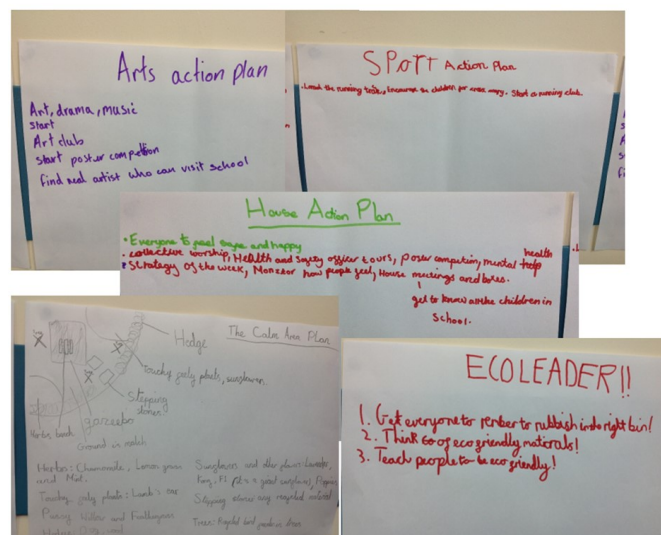
Parent Information Meeting in School

Kate Pike, our Mental Health Support Team Lead, is offering parent workshops in areas such as:

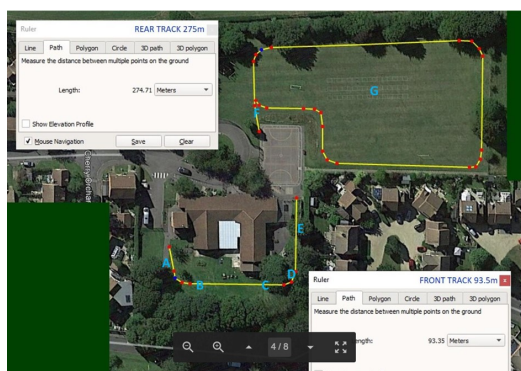
