### START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

### START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Why do you think God uses a garden as an analogy for relationships

### START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Read Proverbs 24:30-31. Why is this garden a picture of neglect? Why is it so easy for a relationship to go from good to bad?
- Read Song of Songs 2:15. What are some of the “little foxes” that you must watch out for in marriage? Talk about how you have dealt with “little foxes” in your marriage relationship.

- Which of the Faith Principles that Pastor Josh talked about most spoke to you?
