KEY SCRIPTURE

Hebrews 12:1-3
John 21:21-22

SERMON POINTS

1. Relinquish Our Burdens
2. Repent of Our Sins
3. Run Our Race
4. Remember Our Savior

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- Name a person of faith who has made an impact in your life. Why?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- As you reflect on Sunday's message, what one principle or insight stands out as being particularly helpful, insightful, or difficult to grasp?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- *Read Hebrews 12:1*
- What are the good things that hinder your walk with Christ the most?
- The passage talks about sins that easily entangle us. What do you do to fight against "that sin" that can quickly become a trap for you?
- Perseverance is key to the race. What part of your faith walk is consistent and faithful? What parts do you struggle with?
- Do you often compare your life with others? How freeing is it to know that we each have a walk marked out for us?
- *Read Hebrews 12:2*
- What do you need to do this week to fix your eyes on Christ and remember what he has done and is going to do?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray for our Southaven campus to stay faithful to the race God has marked out for us. Pray for us to not grow weary and lose heart.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Send an encouraging note to another believer this week
- Share with someone about what God did in your life this week through Hebrews 12:1-3.
