START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Read Mark 6:1-8
- Mark's Gospel traditionally ended on a sad note of fear in verse 8.
- Why do you think Mark would end the Gospel that way?
- What was the reasoning given in sermon? Do you agree, yes or no?
- Answer in sermon = IN MARK THE RESPONSE OF THE DISCIPLES TO REALIZING JESUS MIGHT BE THE MESSIAH, THE SON OF GOD IS OFTEN IF NOT ALWAYS FEAR
- Read Proverbs 9:10-11
- What did fearing God look like at the beginning of your personal relationship with Jesus?
- How has that fear changed over the years?
- What are you doing with your knowledge of the resurrected Jesus
- What is your next step of obedience to Jesus? How can we pray for you to obey?
- Read Mark 6:34
- Do you see Jesus as the Good Shepherd who has compassion on you and those in our world?
- Do you represent that picture of Jesus Christ with your life?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray for China.
- Pray for your one person.

START DOING. Allow Easter to change everything this week!!
