KEY SCRIPTURE

Mark 16:1-8 John 11:23-26 1 Peter 1:3, 8-9

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

What is your favorite Easter food or Easter memory?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

 Why is it so easy for us to be most concerned with things pertaining to this life and not with eternity?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Read Mark 16:1-4. Why is it significant that women were the first witnesses of the resurrection? How do you think you would have reacted to the news they heard that day?
- Read Mark 16:5-7. Why do you think the disciples never really accepted what Jesus had told them about his death? Why did Jesus have to die?
- Read John 11:23-26. How does Jesus's power over death affect the way that we as believers face death now?
- Read 1 Peter 1:3, 8-9. How is it possible for us to believe in Jesus and even love him today even though we cannot see him in the flesh?
 Have some in the group tell their story of how they came to faith.

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

 Take time to simply thank and praise God for the resurrection of Jesus Christ!

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

What is something in the Word that God has been telling you to do lately?
Share what that is with someone, and then DO IT!
