TALK IT OVER

KEY SCRIPTURE

Mark 16:1-8

Romans 6:23

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What is your favorite Easter memory/tradition?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Share a time when you had to overcome adversity in order to succeed?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Read Mark 16:1-3
- The stone at Jesus's tomb was a major talking point in the sermon this week. What did the stone covering the tomb represent?
- How is life without Jesus characterized by death?
- Read Romans 6:23
- Usually when we read this passage we think about death of the body at the end of life. How does sin cause death in other ways?
- Read Mark 16:4-6
- How does the stone rolled away act as a different symbol than the stone covering the tomb?
- What does it mean that Christ has conquered death?
- Now that Christ has risen what does it mean for us now?
- How does eternal life in Christ work itself out in our day-to-day?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray about what actions you can take to live in a way that greater represents new life in Jesus Christ.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- If you haven't already take time this week to memorize Romans 6:23.
