START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

 What is dangerous about the statement, "God just wants me to be happy," and how would you respond to it?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

· Why do we need to fight for the Faith, and how do we do this?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Read Jude 1:3-4. Why do you think Jude was so concerned about the ungodly people who were infiltrating the church? How could someone teach that grace gives us freedom to sin, and how would you answer that kind of teaching?
- Read Jude 1:4-16. What are the main characteristics that Jude points
 out about how these ungodly people live? Why do you think Jude
 stresses their judgment so strongly? How do you see unbelief,
 immorality, and rebellion infiltrating the church these days?
- Read Jude 1:20-23, 2 Peter 1:3-8, and John 14:21. What are some
 ways that you can build yourself up on your faith? Knowing that we
 are already loved and kept by God, how can we keep ourselves in the
 love of God?
- Read Jude 1:24-25. Talk about ways that we can glorify God in our lives.

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

 Pray for someone that you know is struggling with doubts about the faith.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

 This week, really wrestle with God through study and prayer over any scripture that you struggle to accept. Find out why that scripture is true and right..
