**START TALKING.** Find a conversation starter for your group.

- Have you ever had “rapture anxiety?” Do you have any fear about “end times” teachings?

**START THINKING.** Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- When you think about Revelation, what do you think? Who and what have shaped your thinking the most about Revelation?

**START SHARING.** Choose a question to create openness.

- Why are there only seven churches being addressed? Where are these churches located? What extra biblical information do you know about these churches/cities?
- Why is literary genre so important to consider when reading Revelation? Taking Luke’s last sermon (Nov 27th) into consideration, what makes this writing of John unique? What makes Revelation 1 special?
- What is the church at Pergamum like? What was the spiritual climate of this city?
- What is the admonishment of Pergamum? Read Number 31:15-16. Why is unbridled sexuality so problematic?
- What can we learn about “communal sins” or “communal spirits” from Revelation 2 & 3?
- What are the “teachings of the Nicolaitians?” Who is Nicolaus?
- Read 2 Kings 9:30-37. What does this teach us about Jezebel? What does this teach us about the issues of Thyatira?
- What does it mean that tolerance is either “too much or too little” for a Christian? Why is the ultimate virtue of the world tolerance?

**START PRAYING.** Be bold and pray with power.

- Please pray for Christians in our church to stay wise and mindful during the Christmas season, and that they would avoid being “swept away” by a secular Christmas.
