START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- How many characters and names can you recall from 1 Samuel 1-24? Make a list. No cheating.

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Have you been in a situation where there was a clear “leadership vacuum?” Church, work, family, and organization. What was the result?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Why are Nabal and Abigail married?
- What power imbalances exist between the sexes right now? What’s the the line between *unhealthy power imbalance* and *gender distinctiveness*?
- Why is the gospel the best way to deal with power imbalance? How is this different than the world’s way of dealing with power imbalance?
- What makes Nabal a fool? Why is he called a “worthless man?”
- Of the list of things that Luke shared about Nabal’s worthlessness, do any of those things hit close to home?
- What key words and/or phrases are repeated throughout the chapter? Why might the repetition of those things be important?
- What does the sin of favoritism look like? What forms does it take in our life? What motivates favoritism?
- What gospel parallels do we see in this text?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.
