START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Read Proverbs 3:5-6. Meditate, reflect, respond.
- Why does David "lean on his own understanding?" Why would he
 forsake all the other counsel in his life? What does that teach us
 about our humanity?
- Do we need "outside counsel" for every decision in our life? When is it a good idea to seek other counselors for our decision-making?
- If the Holy Spirit is considered a "counselor," why do I need the Bible? Isn't the Holy Spirit enough?
- What is the outcome of David's self-counsel? What are the results?
- Read 1 Kings 12. What does this teach us about earthly counselors?
- What is David's "self counsel" putting 1000s of people at risk? Do you think most people consider the ramifications on others when they make "high stakes" decisions? Why/why not?
- Why is meditation and memorization necessary disciplines for a Christian?
