KEY SCRIPTURE

1 Samuel 26:21-25

1 Samuel 29:1-11

Galatians 6:7-10

POINTS

QUESTION: How Do You Function After Mountain-Top Moments & During Valley Seasons?

TRUTH: Constancy Not Perfection is the Goal of the Follower of Jesus.

ACTION STEP: Continue Following Daily, Faithfully, & Relationally.

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What is the greatest mountain-top moment of your life?
- What is the hardest valley season you can share?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- As you reflect on your personal Bible reading, what is one thing God is teaching you or calling you to walk out in obedience?
- As you reflect on Sunday's message, what one principle or insight stands out as being particularly helpful, insightful, or difficult to grasp?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Will someone share a summary of the story found in 1 Samuel 29.
- What verses stand out in this passage to you? Why? What are some promises, examples, or things to stay away from?
- Think About 1 Samuel 29.
- No moment necessarily jumps off the page. This is a transitional passage. What truth can we learn about faithfulness in the mundane moments from this chapter? Do you find yourself faithful in transition times?
- Read 1 Samuel 29:6-7
- Achish shares what he thinks is true about David. How does David respond? Share about a time where someone said something about you that you knew was false/lie. How did you feel? What was your response?
- Read Galatians 6:7-10
- Frank talked about constancy Sunday. Why does it matter that we are faithful and continue to do good? What strikes you as interesting about verse 10?
- Paul uses the illustration of sowing and reaping. Is there a modern day illustration that helps us understand this passage?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray for our group.
- Pray for your one person to share your faith.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Continue Following Daily, Faithfully, & Relationally.
