START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- To the best of your ability, recap and retell the 1 Samuel story.

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- How is 1 Samuel 29 similar to 1 Samuel 28?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Have you ever struggled to trust people? If so, why? What was your life like when you were operating with distrust?
- Why do the Philistines distrust David? Do they have reason to distrust David?
- Why is trust a spectrum? Why do people think of trust in a dualistic fashion?
- Do you agree with Pastor Luke's take on Luke 16:10-12?
- Why does David speak so much about trust? What book in the Old Testament has the second greatest recording of the word "trust?" (ESV) What other words in the NT encapsulate the concept of trust?
- How do we learn to trust God?
- What does it look like to operate with distrust with the world? What does it look like for the world to distrust Christians?
- How is God saving David from David? How has God saved you from you?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.
