KEY SCRIPTURE

1 Samuel 31

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What are your biggest takeaways from our series in 1 Samuel?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Have you ever learned from someone else's experience and avoided a big mistake?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- **What, if anything, stood out as noteworthy from Sunday's sermon?**
- Humility and pride we keys to 1 Samuel. How can we learn to be more humble?
- **Read 1 Samuel 31:1-10**
- In what ways do God's patience and God's justice reveal themselves in Saul's life, and what does this teach us about God?
- How should understanding God's patience and God's justice teach us how to live personally, and what do they teach us about how we should interact with others?
- Lot's of people felt the consequences of Saul's sin. Why is it so easy to see the effects of others sin in our lives yet not consider the impact of our sin on others?
- What are real ways that our sins effect others that we don't normally consider?
- How do God's condemnation and God's deliverance go hand-in-hand in this chapter, and what might this teach us about God's plan for the world/end times?
- How can we learn to trust in God's deliverance and not try to fight every battle ourselves?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray for someone you know who God is being patient with but who has yet to surrender to the Lord.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Invite someone to church this week for Easter Sunday.
