KEY SCRIPTURE

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

• What makes relationships so important to the human experience?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

 How does knowing that you're designed for relationship with God effect the way you see yourself? What does it say about God?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- · What, if anything, stood out as noteworthy from Sunday's sermon?
- Read Exodus 25:8 and John 2:13-16
- What was God's purpose for the tabernacle/temple, and why do you think Jesus was so upset about it being misused?
- Other than places of worship, what are some other things God gives us that should to point us to him? How do we see the same issues of human misuse?
- In cleansing the temple, what does Jesus teach us about cleansing brokenness and restoring God's plan in the spaces we inhabit?
- Read John 2:18-22 and Revelation 21:2-3, 22
- Jesus refers to his body as the temple that will be torn down and raised back up.
 How is Jesus the temple that makes all other temples unnecessary?
- How does the resurrection prove that Jesus alone is able to really draw God and humanity together?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

 Pray that those who were first time guests or inconsistent attendees will be transformed by what they experienced on Easter Sunday.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

 Look for one way we can expose brokenness and restore God's plan in your regular environments.
