TALK IT OVER

KEY SCRIPTURE

Matthew 6:5-13

Matthew 5:20

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- Talk about a time when you've seen God move in your life in response to prayer.

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- What makes prayer so important to a Christian's spiritual health/development?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- **What, if anything, stood out as noteworthy from Sunday's sermon?**
- **Read Matthew 5:20 and Matthew 6:5-8**
- What big mistake do people normally make when praying, and why can these mistakes be so easy to fall into?
- Which error of these two groups of praying people (hypocrites and Gentiles) are you most tempted to repeat? Why?
- **Read Matthew 6:9-13**
- One at a time, discuss what Jesus is teaching in each of these five verses, taking time to pray as a group before moving on to the next. (Larger groups consider splitting into two groups for prayer)

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray that God will begin to change our hearts to more resemble his.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Set apart a special prayer time this week and pray with your family/the people in your home.
