START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- **What, if anything, stood out from Sunday's sermon?**

- **Read Deuteronomy 6:1-2 and Proverbs 9:10**

- Do you ever think of fearing God as a central part of your relationship with him? What ways does the fear of the Lord influence the way you think of your faith?

- Proverbs 9:10 compares fear of the Lord to having knowledge of the Holy One. How do these two things fit together when we consider knowing God?

- How do we balance the tension between taking sin seriously in all situations and giving grace generously in all situations?

- **Read Deuteronomy 6:4-5**

- What could it look like in real life to love the Lord with all your heart (the seat of your mind and will), with all of your soul (your spiritual being), and with all your strength (with all your physical effort)? Give some practical examples.

- How does understanding our relationship to God lead us to choose love?

- **Read Deuteronomy 6:6-9 and Acts 2:42**

- What are practical ways we can devote ourselves to God in our homes?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray that God will help us to love him and give us wisdom to pursue him fully.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- Develop a practical habit that can help you take a step in following Christ.
