START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

• What are the best Christmas cookies: chocolate chip, sugar, gingerbread, or other? **KEY SCRIPTURE**

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

• How has increased spending changed the way people celebrate Christmas?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Carefully read Luke 1:46-55 (The Magnificat)
- What do you find most unique or interesting about Mary's song of praise?
- How do you think Mary's knowledge shaped her preparation for Jesus, and how should our knowledge of him shape our celebration?
- What are the main differences between a <u>cultural</u> and a <u>devotional</u> celebration of Christmas, and how do we sometimes fall into the cultural Christmas trap?
- What are some ways celebrating Christmas differently might change our outlook and help us present Jesus to people around us (family/friends/etc)?

• Read Ecclesiastes 5:10-12

- Why does Solomon's advice come with added credibility, and how can it help us adjust the way we spend during Christmas?
- Why do you think people so easily believe that having more things will make us happy?
- Read 1 John 2:15
- How does overspending expose our love for the world, and why is that a big deal?
