TALK IT OVER

START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

• What is the worst you have ever been tricked?

START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

• Why is it so easy for us to deceive ourselves? How do we do it?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Read 1 Corinthians 3:18-23. Why does the wisdom of God appear foolish to the worldly-wise? What are some resources that you sought help from before coming to Christ?
- - Read Proverbs 3:5-7 and 2 Chronicles 16:9-13. What does it mean to "trust in the Lord," rather than to "lean on your own understanding?" What was Asa's sin? How do you balance seeking help from God and help from other people?
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- Read 1 Corinthians 4:1-5 and Hebrews 4:12-13. Why did Paul say that he did not judge himself, or trust the judgement of others? How does God's Word help to prepare us for the judgment of God?
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- Read 1 Corinthians 4:6-7 and 2 Corinthians 10:17. What are you
 most proud of? How did it come to be in your life? How can you
 boast in the Lord?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

• As you read the Word, ask God to show you any areas of self-deceit in your life.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

This week, make it a point to give God the glory out loud for any good thing in your life!
