START THINKING. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

• Have you ever had to share a hard truth or have a hard conversation with a friend?

START SHARING. Choose a question to create openness.

- Carefully read 1 Corinthians 5:1-6
- What is the contrasting relationship between arrogance and grief, and why is grief the right response to those stuck in sin habits?
- How is open sin in a single member a real threat to the entire church?

• Read Matthew 18:15-18

- In what way is Paul's situation different that the one Jesus describes? What do we learn because of this difference?
- What seems like the purpose of this kind of church discipline?
- Why do you think we see this so rarely played out in the modern church in the US?

• Read 1 Corinthians 5:9-13

- Why would it be appropriate to judge other believers and not non-Christians?
- What would be the reason for avoiding fellowship with those caught in sin?
- Do you struggle with the idea of church discipline like this? Why or why not?

START PRAYING. Be bold and pray with power.

• Pray for Colonial Hills as we close in on Easter Sunday, for all the work and preparation, and that God would bless by bringing those who need to hear the gospel.

START DOING. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
