- Have you ever considered what your life will be like in eternity? Why do you think its significant we will judge the world and the angels?
- **Read 1 Corinthians 6:4-8 and Matthew 5:13-16**
- What is the responsibility of the believer as it relates to glorifying God in public?
- What do you think is proper or improper as it relates to publicly displaying your faith?
- What does it do to the Christian testimony when we live undisciplined lifestyles in front of non-believers
- How can Christians be thoughtful about the impact of their public lives while still being honest about our struggles?
- How does understanding our eternal call help us forgive wrongs?
