START TALKING. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- How is this text helpful when considering sponsorship for international missionaries?
- Why might the soldier illustration (V7) be the most powerful illustration for church leaders and their compensation?
- What things were not addressed in the sermon about this passage? Ch9:1-18
- Read 1 Timothy 3. How does this text aid 1 Corinthians 9?
- How have you seen God move in your life lately? How are you living on mission?
- · What is one area of your spiritual life that you are struggling in?
