- What things keep Christians from joining in ministry though we've all been called to it?
- Read 1 Corinthians 9:13-18
- Why is it so noteworthy that Paul refuses to be paid, and what does this teach us about how he views the relationship between his finances and his personal joy?
- · Paul's reward was to preach the gospel freely. In what ways is serving God its own reward?
- What allows Christians to find great joy in serving in the roles God calls them to?
- Read Acts 6:2-3 and Acts 13:1-3
- · How did God use the local church to affirm the first deacons, Barnabas, and Saul?
- What role might the local church play now in helping Christians recognize their calling?
