## Governor's Goals for the Initiative

- 1. Washington businesses will improve their ability to compete.
- 2. Businesses will expand the number of skilled employees and add new employees.
- 3. Project leaders will help businesses create succession plans to help with impending employee retirements.
- 4. Existing employees will see an increase in income by advancing their skills.
- 5. Businesses will hire entry-level workers to "backfill" newly open positions helping unemployed or underemployed individuals, especially those with barriers.

## 8 UBI Demonstration Projects

Competitive Bid Process opened in January 2017 8 projects were selected and approved in May & October 2017

18-month projects (started in June 2017)

7 counties – project implementation locations


6 regional Workforce Development Councils 4 sectors – healthcare, construction, manufacturing, and maritime

21 business partners

\$1.95 million funded (partner leveraged \$1.85 million)

Completed 2 phases of competitive bidding


