2018 WPPA LEGISLATIVE SESSION REPORT

TWO BILLS OF PARTICULAR INTEREST PASSED:



- PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTING
 - Unit-Priced Contracting Allowed
 - Bid Limit of \$40,000 Created



- BROADBAND AUTHORITY
 - Expanded and Modernized

Both went into effect on June 7, 2018

UNIT-PRICED CONTRACTING

NOW ALLOWED under RCW 53.08.120 (3)


- Competitively bid for work anticipated on a recurring basis.
- Contract term not to exceed 3 years, with option to renew for one additional year.
- Bid invitations must included estimated quantity of work, how work will be assigned.

UNIT-PRICED CONTRACTING

- NOW ALLOWED under RCW 53.08.120 (3)
 - Bids awarded to lowest responsible bidder.
 - Prevailing wages to be paid + paid at rate in effect at the beginning date of EACH contract year.

BID LIMITS:

- RCW 53.08.120 (c) added to clarify that bids are not required for work that does not exceed \$40,000.
- Public works project means a complete project. It does not permit dividing the project into units or classes of work to avoid bids.
