Purpose: Rebuilding Together's Community Advisory Committee (CAC) will advise Rebuilding Together on its home repair and community revitalization work, specifically in the Greater Bordeaux community.

What are the responsibilities of the CAC?

- -Attending bi-monthly CAC meetings
- -Reviewing and selecting community projects
- -Serving as community liaisons to our Board of Directors
- -Assisting and attending outreach events
- -Helping with hospitality at volunteer days
- -Making introductions between Rebuilding Together and their networks
- -Supporting Rebuilding Together staff as needed
- -Agreeing to be listed on print and web materials as members of the CAC

Who will serve on the CAC?

5-10 individuals, a majority of whom will reside in the Greater Bordeaux boundaries. Membership will not be limited to homeowners, but previous recipients of Rebuilding Together's services are encouraged to apply.

How will members be selected?

- -Members of the community will self-nominate or nominate someone via a 1-page application (coming soon)
- -Proposed members of the CAC will be recommended by Rebuilding Together's staff and approved by the Rebuilding Together Program committee

What support and benefits would a CAC member receive?

-Stipend to cover costs of travel to meetings and time; an opportunity to use your time and talents to better your community!
