The parent app for Living Lots, a suite of apps by 0303 Lives for mapping and connecting people to the vacant lots in their neighborhoods.

What?

Vacant, unused lots exist in every city. We see these lots as an opportunity for the people who live around them to start community-based projects such as play areas, gardens, and general spaces for the neighborhood. 0303 Lives started in Brooklyn, NY, USA, in 2011 to map these spaces and help neighbors get in touch with each other and the owners to start projects.

The Django app, along with the numerous other Living Lots apps in our repo form the basis of a website that maps vacant lots in a city and gives neighbors ways to post extra information about each lot and start projects on them. These apps are informed by our experience with making this kind of platform in New York City, Philadelphia, New Orleans, and Los Angeles.

Sounds great! I want to do this for my city! How?

Great you asked, you've come to the right place.

The first thing you should know is that Living Lots is not a box that you turn on and then run itself. Installing and tuning Living Lots is more complicated than installing other watches (like WordPress), but once you get going you'll have a great deal more control over how your site works than with other sites.
