Four Most Common Ways That God Speaks to Us

1. God Speaks Through the **BIBLE**

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NLT) All Scripture is <u>inspired by God</u> and is useful to <u>teach</u> us what is <u>true</u> and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. ¹⁷ God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

2. God Speaks Through **TEACHERS**

1 Thessalonians 2:13 (ESV) And we also thank God constantly for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the word of God, which is at work in you believers.

3. God Speaks Through **IMPRESSIONS**

Proverbs 20:30 (GNB) Sometimes it takes a painful experience to make us change our ways.

Psalms 119:67, 71 (NLT) I used to wander off until you disciplined me; but now I <u>closely</u> <u>follow your word</u>.
